At the bottom of the list of images are arrow buttons which allow you to scroll through the pages of results if there's more than one.

Choose an image by **clicking on the button to the left of it** (Don't click on the image itself.) and a larger version of the image will jump out at you.




Sometimes the picture you now see is just the first of a series.

You can scroll through them by clicking on the arrows bottom right

There are actually 4 in this set and I've clicked through to the third one in the picture below.

Now click on the Information button bottom left.



Another box will jump out at you, this time revealing the information we have about this set of images. If you look down towards the bottom, you'll see confirmation that there are 4 images in this particular group
